Homecoming Court 2021

On October 7, 2021, Home Education Partnership of Texas, Inc. will host the Homecoming Barn Dance. One of the highlights of the evening will be the presentation of HEP of Texas's homecoming court. The court will consist of a 12th grade King and Queen, 11th grade Prince and Princess, 10th grade Duke and Duchess, and 9th grade Lord and Lady.

If you would like to run for the court, here are the guidelines:

1. Fill out an application to run for the court. Available on www.heptx.com, at the school, or in the Teacher Ease Digital Locker.
2. Students must be current HEP TX students in good standing (overall C or 70 average in HEP TX classes as shown on TE at the of time you turn in the application).
3. Students are eligible to run only for their grade level position on the court (ie. 9th graders will run for the 9th grade position of Lord or Lady, etc.). Only males may run for male positions; only females may run for female positions.
4. Complete the application and turn it in no later than 9/29/21.
5. You may campaign once we receive your application and approve it. HEP TX Staff will approve all campaign posters before they are posted at HEP TX.
6. The court candidates will be announced on 9/30/21 via Teacher Ease, HEP TX webpage, Facebook, and in print at HEP TX.

Voting

1. Voting will begin on 9/30/21 and run through 10/6/21.
2. Only current 9th -12th grade HEP TX students may run for the court. Students who do not take classes at HEP TX may NOT run for the court or vote for the court.
3. Students younger than 9th grade may NOT run or vote for the court.
4. 9th grade students will vote for the 9th grade court; 10th grade students will vote for the 10th grade court; 11th grade students will vote for the 11th grade court; 9-12th grade students will vote for the 12th grade court.
5. Each HEP TX 9-12th grade student will receive a ballot with his/her name on it.
6. Put your ballot in the ballot box at HEP TX. The ballot is due no later than 10/6/2021. No late ballots will be accepted as the ballot box will go to the counting team at 4 pm on 10/6/21.
7. Winners will be announced and presented at the 2021 Homecoming Barn Dance on Oct. 7, 2021.

Vote Counting

1. Ballots will be secret.
2. Votes will be tallied by the HEP TX faculty/staff.
